## **Description:**

The Teacher Education Department of Toccoa Falls College invites applications for an adjunct teaching position with an emphasis in English as a Second Language (ESL) beginning Spring, 2017. Primary duties include teaching one-3-hour class entitled Classroom ESL Methodology & Practicum. The class services teacher candidates who are seeking an ESOL Endorsement on the undergraduate level. Part of the responsibilities is overseeing practicum hours in an ESL K-12 classroom.

## **Qualifications:**

- Ph. D./Ed. D., Masters in ESL, TESOL, or an ESOL Endorsement with state certification preferred.
- Experience as a college instructor is preferred.
- Ability to mentor teacher candidates working with English language learners (ELL).
- The knowledge and ability to use technology and integrate these into classroom delivery systems and current practice in the PK-8 classroom.
- Candidates must be committed Christians who are devoted to Christ-centered higher education.
- The candidate must be knowledgeable about English language development methodologies, technology, and techniques used to incorporate the ELL into the regular classroom. These practices are enhanced by a 35-hour practicum with an ESL certified teacher within a local school system.
