

Adjunct Instructor of Freshman Composition (ENG 113)

Toccoa Falls College seeks applicants for an adjunct instructor of Freshman Composition for Fall Semester 2017, beginning 8/21/2016. Qualifications include an earned graduate degree (M.A. or Ph.D.) with 18 hours of graduate work in writing, TESOL, or related field, and a positive work/teaching record. Candidates should also have a passion for encouraging students, and the ability to communicate effectively.

Responsibilities involve teaching a 3-hour Freshman Composition class. Previous teaching experience is strongly desired. Candidates must be committed believers devoted to the Christ-centered higher educational mission of the College. Adjuncts receive a \$1,500 stipend plus travel expenses if commuting from outside the county.

Toccoa Falls College is a four-year Christian college affiliated with the Christian and Missionary Alliance, holding to a strong evangelical position, and is a full member of the Council for Christian Colleges & Universities (CCCU). TFC is located in the foothills of the Great Smoky Mountains, 95 miles northeast of Atlanta, Georgia.
