**Qualifications:** The ideal candidate will hold an earned Ph.D. or D.B.A. from a regionally accredited university in Sport Management; possess professional management experience; and be academically and/or professionally qualified by current SACSCOC standards. Previous teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate level is highly desirable. Exceptional applicants with a masters' degree in Sport Management or related field will be considered.

**Responsibilities:** Primary responsibilities include teaching traditional undergraduate courses, student advising, and service to the college and department. Candidates should be able to teach courses in the various business areas of sport management. The typical teaching load is 12 credit-hours per semester.
