Overview

Toccoa Falls College seeks applicants for Adjunct Instructor of Biblical Studies and Christian Theology for their online program. Persons will teach courses in support of the Biblical Studies Major in the online degree program. Teaching load is based upon department needs each semester and may vary. Applicants should have a positive work/teaching record, a passion to positively influence students, and an ability to effectively communicate in an online environment. Selected candidates are not required to relocate geographically. Additionally a commitment to the integration of faith and learning with a student centered approach to teaching is valued.

Responsibilities

A Masters Degree along with a robust number of hours of postgraduate course work in the area to be taught; Ph.D. strongly preferred; Ability to teach in more than 1 area strongly preferred; 1-2 years of online educational experience preferred.
