Responsibilities

Responsibilities involve teaching a 3-credit hour online course. Candidates must be committed believers devoted to the Christ-centered higher educational mission of the College and abide by its lifestyle standards. A familiarity or willingness to learn Moodle, our online course platform, is required.
