Secondary or collegiate teaching experience is strongly desired, as well as a passion to influence students positively, and an ability to communicate effectively. Additionally a commitment to the integration of faith and learning with a student centered approach to teaching is valued.

Responsibilities

Responsibilities involve teaching 3-credit hour online courses. Current course needs include Mathematical Modeling, College Algebra, and Introduction to Statistics. Candidates must be committed believers devoted to the Christ-centered higher educational mission of the College and abide by its lifestyle standards. A familiarity or willingness to learn Moodle, our online course platform, is required.
