ONLINE

Courses can be taken online in one of two accelerated 8-week sessions (designated as session A and session B) or in one full-semester 16-week session. The same content is covered at varying paces, and the same amount of credit hours is earned for completion of a course in any of these venues.

RESIDENTIAL

Courses can be taken on Toccoa Falls College’s campus residentially for the full 16-week semester. Courses either meet on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays (M/W/F) for 50-minute periods or on Tuesdays and Thursdays (T/Th) for one-hour and 15 minute periods, with exception of lab hours. Participating Dual Enrolled students are not required to live in our Residence Halls.

PREREQUISITES

Courses with prerequisites—requiring transfer credit for or the completion of a previous course—are specified with an asterisk (*). Please keep this in mind when selecting courses for Dual Enrollment.
