ONLINE COURSES

Courses can be taken online in one of two accelerated 8-week sessions (designated as session A and session B) or in one full-semester 16-week session. The same content is covered at varying paces, and the same amount of credit hours is earned for completion of a course in any of these venues.

RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

Residential courses are offered in 16 week lengths.

GAFUTURES FUNDING LIMITS

Students are permitted to take up to 15 credit hours a semester across all postsecondary colleges. A student, approved by the Eligible High School or Home Study program and the Eligible Postsecondary Institution, may participate in the Dual Enrollment Program during his or her 11th and/or 12th grade years (10th grade if SAT/ACT High Achiever Scores are met). Eligibility may not be extended beyond a student's 12th grade year. In accordance with HB 444, the State has limited funding eligibility to 30 credits total. A repeat/retake of a course will not be eligible for funding. If the student has withdrawn from more than one Dual Enrolled Course since the Spring 2020 Semester, he or she is no longer eligible to receive State funding.

PREREQUISITES

Courses with prerequisites—requiring transfer credit for or the completion of a previous course—are specified with an asterisk (*). Please keep this in mind when selecting courses for Dual Enrollment.
