ONLINE COURSES

Courses can be taken online in one of two accelerated 8-week sessions (designated as session A and session B) or in one full-semester 16-week session. The same content is covered at varying paces, and the same amount of credit hours is earned for completion of a course in any of these venues.

GAFUTURES FUNDING LIMITATIONS

A student, approved by the eligible High School or Home Study program and the eligible Postsecondary Institution, may participate in the Dual Enrollment Program during their 11th and/or 12th grade years (10th grade if SAT/ACT High Achiever Scores and GPA are met). Eligibility may not be extended beyond a student’s 12th grade year. Students are permitted to take up to 15 credit hours per semester across all postsecondary colleges. In accordance with HB 444, the State has limited total funding eligibility to 30 credits. A repeat/retake of a course will not be eligible for funding. If the student has withdrawn from more than one dual enrolled course, he or she is no longer eligible to receive State funding.

PREREQUISITES

Courses with prerequisites—requiring transfer credit for or the completion of a previous course—are specified with an asterisk (*).
