



**Position Title:** Faculty Position in Communication Studies

**POSITION SUMMARY:**

The Humanities Department at Toccoa Falls College invites applications for a full-time faculty position in the field of Communication Studies starting August 1, 2023. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The department seeks a dynamic and innovative individual to join our Communication Studies faculty in the instruction, oversight, and development of courses that are part of the Communication Studies major.

**TASKS:**

Qualified candidates will have the opportunity to teach a variety of courses including introductory to upper-level courses in Communication Studies. Potential courses, depending on the candidate's experience and background, may include Introduction to Communication, Public Relations, Journalism, Social Media, Mentoring, Research Methods, and Media Production. We are particularly interested in candidates who can develop and teach innovative undergraduate courses in the area of Branding and Social Media Management.

Academic advising and committee work are expectations of the position. Participation in program curriculum development, mentoring undergraduate students, serving on assigned committees, and maintaining required office hours are also requirements.

**SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:**

The ideal candidate should be a Spiritually mature Christian with a vibrant evangelical Christian faith, who is in agreement with the college statement of faith, and committed to the vision, mission and values of Toccoa Falls College. The outstanding candidate, dedicated to a spirit of collaboration and teamwork, should also demonstrate evidence of strong teaching skills integrating faith and learning.

**EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION:**

To be considered, all candidates must have a minimum of a Master's in Communication from an accredited institution; an earned doctorate is preferred. Prior college teaching experience is desirable.
