- Prepare course syllabi, exams, audiovisual materials, and other teaching learning activities that facilitate student learning experiences.
- Participate in assessment and evaluation of course objectives, goals, and student outcomes as required by the College, Georgia Board of Nursing, and The Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.
- Participate in academic advising and counseling of pre-nursing and nursing students consistent with current School of Nursing requirements and Christian values.
- Demonstrate achievement of faculty outcomes which contribute to the attainment of the College and School of Nursing's mission and goals.

SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:

Qualified applicants will evidence strong teaching skills, the ability to integrate faith and learning, a vibrant evangelical Christian faith, commitment to collaboration and teamwork, and a sincere commitment to the mission of the college.

EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION:
