**POSITION SUMMARY:**

Toccoa Falls College seeks an online adjunct professor of Earth Science for Fall semester 2023. Qualifications include an earned graduate degree (M.Ed., M.S., Ed.D., or Ph.D.) with significant graduate coursework related to the atmospheric, geological or physical sciences.

**TASKS:**

Tasks involve teaching a 3-credit hour introductory Earth Science course covering the basics of astronomy, meteorology, hydrology and geology (SCI 243). Opportunities for multiple sections are available. Adjuncts receive a \$1,600 stipend per class with 5-20 students.

**SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:**

Spiritually mature Christian in agreement with the college statement of faith and committed to the vision, mission and values of Toccoa Falls College.

**EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION:**
