

# **Dual Enrollment Registration Instructions**

# 1. APPLY FOR STATE FUNDING

Each semester, ensure that you have completed and submitted the online Dual Enrollment Funding Application at GAFutures.org.

- Verify that you have submitted a funding application for the appropriate school year ask your school counselor if you aren't sure!
- Make sure that you have added "Toccoa Falls College" to your funding application.
- Ask your parent/guardian to submit the <u>Parent Participation Agreement</u> (sent to them via email)

Completing this application does not automatically register you for classes but is **required** before you can be registered. This is the *only* way for you to receive funding for your selected courses.

# 2. CHOOSE YOUR COURSES

Each semester, fill out the TFC Dual Enrollment Registration Packet after you have met with your High School Counselor/Homeschool Official to determine which classes are right for you.

This packet contains two forms:

- 1. Funding Acknowledgments Form
- 2. Registration Form

Both forms are found in this document. **Both** forms must be completed and submitted to <u>dualenrollment@tfc.edu</u> before you can be registered.

# 3. SUBMIT THIS PACKET TO TFC

Once your forms have been signed, submit them to the Dual Enrollment Office at <u>dualenrollment@tfc.edu</u>. If you're missing anything, we'll let you know!

# Who is eligible to receive state funding?

- 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are not eligible.
- 10<sup>th</sup> grade students\* are *only* eligible with a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration.
- 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible, assuming the funding cap has not been exceeded (see below).
- Any student who attends high school outside of the state of Georgia is not eligible to receive state funding.

# What are the limits on the Georgia Dual Enrollment funding program?

- The Dual Enrollment Funding Cap is 30 semester hours, taken with any postsecondary institution.
  - o Students are not permitted to receive funding for more than 15 credit hours each semester.
- Per Georgia state law, all male students who are at least 18 years of age must complete federal Selective Service requirements to receive program funding.

#### Can a student retake or withdraw from a Dual Enrollment course?

- A student may not receive funding for the same course twice.\*
- Students are ineligible to continue to receive Dual Enrollment funding after their 2<sup>nd</sup> course withdrawal.

### Can a student take Dual Enrollment courses at Toccoa Falls College outside of program funding?

• Students who have exhausted funding eligibility or are ineligible to receive funding may choose to self-pay for additional credits/courses at the discounted rate of \$250 per credit hour\* + the cost of textbooks.

### Please read the following statement and sign below:

I acknowledge and understand the above conditions for Dual Enrollment Funding in addition to the guidelines set forth by GAFutures. I recognize that, as the student, I am responsible for keeping track of my funding eligibility—this responsibility does not fall to the high school counselor or to the Dual Enrollment Coordinator. I also recognize that a Funding Acknowledgements Form must be submitted to Toccoa Falls College for each term of enrollment.

<sup>\*</sup>This limitation is set by GAFutures.  $10^{th}$  grade students can be accepted to Toccoa Falls College without test scores, but the understanding is that these students will pay out of pocket for all courses until their  $11^{th}$  grade year.

<sup>\*</sup>This includes courses that a student has withdrawn from.

<sup>\*</sup>You can tell how many credit hours a course is worth by looking at the last digit of the TFC Course Code. If you're not sure, you can always ask!
