ONLINE COURSES

During the Summer semester, courses are offered during one accelerated 8-week session (designated as session A). The same number of credits are earned in an 8-week session that are earned in a full semester-long course.

GAFUTURES FUNDING LIMITATIONS *(Adapted from GAFutures.com)*

11th - 12th grade* students, enrolled in and approved by an eligible public, private, or homestudy program in Georgia, may participate in the GAFutures Dual Enrollment Program. The Dual Enrollment Funding Cap is 30 semester hours across all postsecondary institutions, and students may not exceed 15 hours within a given semester. Students must meet federal Selective Service registration requirements, per Georgia state law. A repeat/retake of a course is not eligible for funding, and a student is no longer eligible to continue to receive program funding after withdrawing from Dual Enrollment course(s) two (2) times.

**10th graders may access GAFutures funding eligibility early with a 1200 on the SAT or a 26 on the ACT*
