

Position Title: *Online Adjunct Faculty – Precalculus* **Reports to:** *Vice President for Distance Education*

Appointment: TFC Adjunct Faculty during Summer 2024 Session

POSITION SUMMARY:

Toccoa Falls College seeks an online adjunct professor of Precalculus MAT 143 for the 2024 Summer Session. Qualifications include an earned graduate degree with 18 graduate hours of coursework related to mathematics.

TASKS:

Tasks involve teaching a 3-credit hour Precalculus (MAT 143) course. MAT 143 covers fundamental principles of trigonometry, comprising algebraic and trigonometric exploration. Specific topics of the course include polynomial, exponential, logarithmic, and trigonometric functions and their graphs. Additional topics in analytic trigonometry shall be studied. The course is intended to precede and prepare students for Calculus I and requires students to have background knowledge of College Algebra (MAT 133). Opportunities for multiple sections are available. Adjuncts receive a \$1,700 stipend per class with 5-20 students.

SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:

Spiritually mature Christian in agreement with the college statement of faith and committed to the vision, mission and values of Toccoa Falls College.

EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION:

Previous teaching experience in a secondary or collegiate setting is strongly desired, as well as a passion to influence students positively, and an ability to effectively articulate the relationship between science and faith. Candidates must be committed believers devoted to the Christ-centered higher educational mission of the College and abide by its lifestyle standards.
