

Position Title: Assistant Professor of Music Education and Director of Bands

Position Summary:

The Music Department at Toccoa Falls College invites applications for a full-time faculty position starting August 1, 2024. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The position will primarily be tasked with the instruction and oversight of courses in music education and instrumental music.

Tasks:

- Teaching music education courses and directing the instrumental ensembles
- Coordinating the music education curriculum in collaboration with the music and teacher education departments
- Preparing and submitting timely grade reports
- Organizing class assignments and relating them to the overall learning outcomes of the course
- Providing input and working with other faculty and staff to evaluate program effectiveness
- Advising students regarding course selections, graduation requirements, and other policies and procedures of the college and the music department
- Serving on assigned faculty committees
- Other duties as assigned

Skills & Attributes:

Qualified candidates will evidence strong teaching skills, the ability to integrate faith and learning, a vibrant evangelical Christian faith, commitment to collaboration and teamwork, and a sincere commitment to the mission of the college.

Experience & Education:

The ideal candidate will hold either a doctoral or master's degree from a regionally accredited university and possess experience in teaching music and worship arts. Previous teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate level is highly desirable.
