Who is eligible to receive state funding?

- 11th and 12th grade students are eligible, assuming the funding cap has not been exceeded (see below).
- 10th grade students are *only* eligible with a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration. *
- 9th grade students are not eligible.
- The Georgia Student Finance Commission requires students to Georgia residents and US citizens or eligible non-citizens to receive state funding.
- Any student who attends high school outside of the state of Georgia is not eligible to receive state funding.

**This limitation is set by GAFutures. 10th grade students can be accepted to Toccoa Falls College without test scores, but the understanding is that these students will pay out of pocket for all courses until their 11th grade year.*

What are the limits on the Georgia Dual Enrollment funding program?

- The Dual Enrollment Funding Cap is 30 credit hours, taken with any postsecondary institution.
 - Students are not permitted to receive funding for more than 15 credit hours each semester.
- Per Georgia state law, all male students who are at least 18 years of age must complete federal Selective Service requirements to receive program funding.

Can a student retake or withdraw from a Dual Enrollment course?

- A student may not receive funding for the same course twice.
- Students lose GAFutures eligibility after their second course withdrawal.

**This includes courses that a student has withdrawn from.*

Can a student take Dual Enrollment courses at Toccoa Falls College outside of program funding?

- Students may choose to pay for credits/courses out-of-pocket at the discounted rate of \$250 per credit hour if they have already used their 30 credit hours of funding or are ineligible for funding.

I acknowledge and understand the above conditions for Dual Enrollment Funding in addition to the guidelines set forth by GAFutures. I recognize that, as the student, I am responsible for keeping track of my funding eligibility—this responsibility does not fall to the high school counselor or to the Dual Enrollment Coordinator. I recognize that a Funding Acknowledgements Form must be submitted to Toccoa Falls College for each semester of enrollment.
